- Basis for regulation locally
 - Zoning, health & safety, building and fire inspections

- San Antonio City Council enacted STR ordinance. (11/1/19)
 - Applies to over 2,000 STRs
 - Permit requirements
 - Fees
 - Limitation on non-owner occupied STRs per block
 - about 1/8 of all STRs on a block can be non-owneroccupied

- Regulations modeled on San Francisco
- Listings dropped from 10,000 to 4,000 in
- First violation: \$20,000

New York City

- City of New York v. Metropolitan Property Group, et al. (1/14-19)
- \$21,000,000 suit
- Alleges firm used fake identities and 18 corporate accounts to run an illegal hotel operation
- Using Airbnb in 35 Manhattan buildings
- 75,000 guests 2015-2018, \$21 million profit
